1. Play is a lot of fun. Everyone loves to play, even adults.

2. Did you know that play is a great way for kids to learn new things?

- Blocks are a great way for kids to explore the effects of gravity.
- Scribbling and drawing teaches kids muscle control.
- Playing catch helps kids to learn eye-hand coordination.
- 3. **Playing with others is also important.** It helps kids learn about things, like how to get along with each other and how to problem solve.
- 4. There are several different types of play that your child will benefit from:
 - **Solitary Play:** Playing alone reading, drawing, working on puzzles.
 - Parallel Play: Children play next to each other doing their own thing. One kid makes a castle in the sand while the other kid makes pies
 - **Cooperative Play:** Children play together pretending, board games, card games.
- 5. Remember, playing should be fun and exciting. Help your child to learn in this fun and creative way.
