

# What Does All Kids/Medicaid Cover?

*Disclaimer: All Kids/Medicaid are not DSCC programs and DSCC does not decide coverage for those programs. This document is meant to be a helpful guide.*

All Kids/Medicaid covers many services, providing comprehensive medical, dental, vision and pharmacy benefits. Below are examples of what may be covered in each of these areas. Please note this is not a complete list.

\*Some of these services are for certain age groups only and may require that your child has a specific medical need. There may be certain limitations to the amount of service or item. For example, diapers are only considered for a child age 4 and up. For formula, the child must have a specific medical need to receive their nutrition by formula.

## Medical



- Doctor appointments
- Specialist visits
- Lab work
- Surgery
- Inpatient hospitalization

## Medical Supplies



- Diapers\*
- Feeding supplies
- Formula\*
- Infusion supplies
- Oxygen

## Mental Health Services



- Inpatient hospitalization
- Outpatient behavioral health services to include counseling and medication monitoring.
- Neuropsychological evaluations
- Crisis intervention for youth age 20 and younger (SASS)

## Pharmacy



- Prescriptions
- In some cases, over the counter medications and/or vitamins are covered

## Dental



- Oral exams and cleanings every six months
- Sealants
- Fluoride
- Crowns, root canals, etc.
- Extractions
- Anesthesia and sedation when medically necessary
- Note: Some services are only available for children through age 21.

## Assisted Living



- Residential facilities coverage
- Long-term care facilities

## Durable Medical Equipment



- Wheelchairs
- Commode chairs, bath chairs
- CPAP devices and nebulizers
- Crutches, canes, walkers, etc.
- Hospital beds
- Blood sugar meters and strips
- Assistive communication devices
- Internal lifts
- Stairclimbers (only if there is an internal residence need)

## Therapy



- Physical therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Speech therapy
- Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) therapy

## Transportation



- Transportation to appointments (All Kids Premium 2 is excluded from this benefit.)
- Emergency transportation, such as an ambulance when there is an urgent medical emergency

## Vision



- Eye exams
- Eyeglass frames and prescription lenses, bifocals and trifocals
- Specialty frames such as Miraflex, if medically necessary
- Contact lenses, if medically necessary

## Orthodontia



- Orthodontia is covered for those who meet certain criteria. Some examples of qualifying conditions include:
- Cleft palate
  - Deep impinging bite with signs of tissue damage
  - Anterior crossbite with gingival recession
  - Severe traumatic deviation
