

Do you qualify for free dental care?



You could qualify for free, comprehensive dental care at the new, state-of-the-art TAG Oral Care Center for Excellence.

In order to be eligible, you must live in Illinois, AND meet at least one of the following criteria: *(check all that apply)*

- Enrolled in Medicaid, OR
- Eligible for Medicaid, OR
- Do not have dental insurance AND have an annual income at or below double the federal poverty level

You may qualify, if you have one or more of the following conditions:

- Missing teeth
- Cracked teeth
- Need a tooth replaced
- Wear dentures

The Federal Poverty Level Annual Income


Number of Persons in Household:	Federal Poverty Level:	Twice the FPL. If you make less than this, you qualify for free dental care.
1	\$12,880	\$25,760
2	\$17,420	\$34,840
3	\$21,960	\$43,920
4	\$26,500	\$53,000
