Dear Children's Community-Based Healthcare Center Providers,

Thank you for your dedicated service to participants in the Home Care Program. The Division of Specialized Care for Children (DSCC), on behalf of the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS), is committed to streamlining our claims process to better serve you and our participants.

We want to inform you that the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has approved the 2025 rate increases pertaining to home nursing and respite care. The increased rate for transitional care services is still not approved by Federal CMS.

The respite rates will be retroactive to Jan. 1, 2025. We will provide additional communication about the procedure to adjust previously paid claims from Jan. 1, 2025, to the present. We will begin accepting new claims with the 2025 rates starting May 12, 2025.

You can review the HFS Rate Increase for Nursing Notice posted on Nov. 26, 2024, for more details on this topic.

The new rates are as follows:

• Out-of-home respite: from \$54 per hour to \$57.78 per hour

DSCC will provide an additional update when the transitional care rate increase is approved.
